Children's Policy

The Land O' Lakes Library encourages families with children to use our children's area. This policy is in place to provide for the safety of all children using the Land O' Lakes Library.

1. All children, at all times, should be attended to adequately supervised by an adult or a mature adolescent other than library staff.
2. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children's behavior whenever children are on library grounds. This is a controlled environment and we're not equipped for childcare. The library does not assume responsibility for any child's behavior or well-being.
3. It is not the function of the librarian/staff/volunteer to deal with children who are out of control. Any child deemed out of control by the library staff will be asked to leave. If it is necessary library staff will call the child's parent and or the Vilas County Sherriff's Department.
4. Conversation and manners should be quiet and polite.
5. Please do not re-shelve books, they can be set on a table or placed in the return cart.
