

XVIII. Emergency Closing Policy

Snow storms

The Library will follow the recommendation and actions of the Drummond Area School District regarding winter snowstorm closures Monday through Friday. Saturday snow storm-related closures will be at the discretion of the Library Director. The Library Director shall notify the Library Board President or next available officer or Board member via text or email when such closures occur. If the Drummond Area School district closes for cold and wind-chill concerns rather than snow accumulation, the library will remain open.

Power outages


In case of a power outage, Xcel Electric should be advised of the outage and should be able to provide an estimate of when services may be expected to be restored.

- If service is expected to be restored within an hour and if there is sufficient light to read, the library may remain open and manually record check-outs.
- If it is too dark to conduct basic operations, staff may close the library. They should advise the Library Director and/or the Library Board President, place a sign in the window explaining the closure.
